

Super Bowl LIX Infrastructure Update

Week of December 9

Completed Projects (benefit = 15 years)

- **Poydras Street** – new paving and striping from S. Galvez to Convention Center Blvd.
- **Julia Street** – new paving and striping from Loyola to Convention Center Blvd.
- **Girod Street** – new paving and striping from Loyola to S. Liberty
- **Union Passenger Terminal** – new paving and striping, refreshed landscaping
- **Superdome Campus** – new paving and striping, utility repairs
- **French Quarter Sidewalk** – repairing Royal St sidewalks (Pere Antoine to Pirates Alley)
- **CBD Sidewalks** – Magazine St, Tchoupitoulas St, Peters St, Camp St (all Canal to Poydras)
- **Eternal Seeds Mural** – located on Hyatt New Orleans wall on Girod St

Repaired streets expected to last ~15 years

Repaired sidewalks expected to last ~10 years

Projects for the Week

- **French Quarter Road Repaving** (benefit = ~15 years)
 - Chartres Street – milling operations began in 100 – 300 blocks
- **CBD Road Repaving** (benefit = ~15 years)
 - Old Poydras St – patching & concrete operations between S. Broad to S. Galvez
 - S. Broad Ave – concrete operations between Howard Ave. to Euphrosine St
 - Perdido St – concrete repairs between S. Claiborne to S. Galvez
 - **Perdido (between S Galvez and S Claiborne) will be closed from Dec 15 -19**
- **Hotel Collapse Site Sidewalk/Road/Utility Repair** (benefit = ~15 years)
 - N. Rampart – street restoration underway, one lane is open to traffic
 - Iberville – roadway restoration ongoing
 - Canal – crews are pouring the curb and gutter this week
 - Burgundy – street restoration continues
- **Sidewalk Repair** (benefit = ~15 years)
 - Dumaine Street– Dauphine to Royal
 - 400 Gov. Nicholls
 - Pirates Alley
 - Lafayette Square – St. Charles to Camp
 - S. Rampart Sidewalks – Poydras to Canal
- **New Bourbon St Bollards** (benefit = traffic management safety in FQ for 10+ years)
 - Bourbon St at Conti St – work continuing
 - Bourbon St at Orleans St – work continuing
- **Downman Rd Repaving** (benefit = ~15 years for New Orleans East residents)
 - Scope of work Hayne Blvd to Chef Menteur Hwy
 - Paving continues, with expected completion this week

Week of December 9

- Sidewalk repairs are ongoing, including on Lincoln Beach Blvd & Providence Pl.
- **French Quarter Street Sign Installation** – work planned to begin this week (benefit = ~10 years)
- **HEAL Garage Mural** (benefit = ~10 years)
 - BMIKE continues to paint mural on Duncan Plaza-facing wall of HEAL Garage

Future Projects (not full list)

- **French Quarter Road Repair**
 - 400–600 blocks of Chartres Street
 - 1000-900 blocks of St. Peter Street
 - 500–600 blocks of Conti Street
 - 200 block of Clinton Street
 - 1100 block of St. Louis Street
- **Central Business District Street Repaving**
 - Perdido Street – milling and paving operations between S Galves and S Claiborne
 - Old Poydras St – patching & concrete operations between S Broad and S Galvez
 - Union Street – milling & concrete operations between S Rampart and Carondelet
 - Howard Ave – paving operations, interrupting RTA services on Perdido & Howard
- **Lighting Repairs**
 - French Quarter lighting repairs begin following surveys
 - I-10 lighting between Perdido St and Howard Ave
 - Final steps for Canal St light pole basis – sand blasting, painting, and welding
- **Project French Doors**
 - Rehabilitating first 100 blocks of Dauphine, Bourbon, Royal, Chartres, Decatur
 - Street Murals
 - Mural on Dauphine Street
 - Lighting repairs (private and public)
- **City Courthouse Mural**
- **Girod Overpass Mural**
